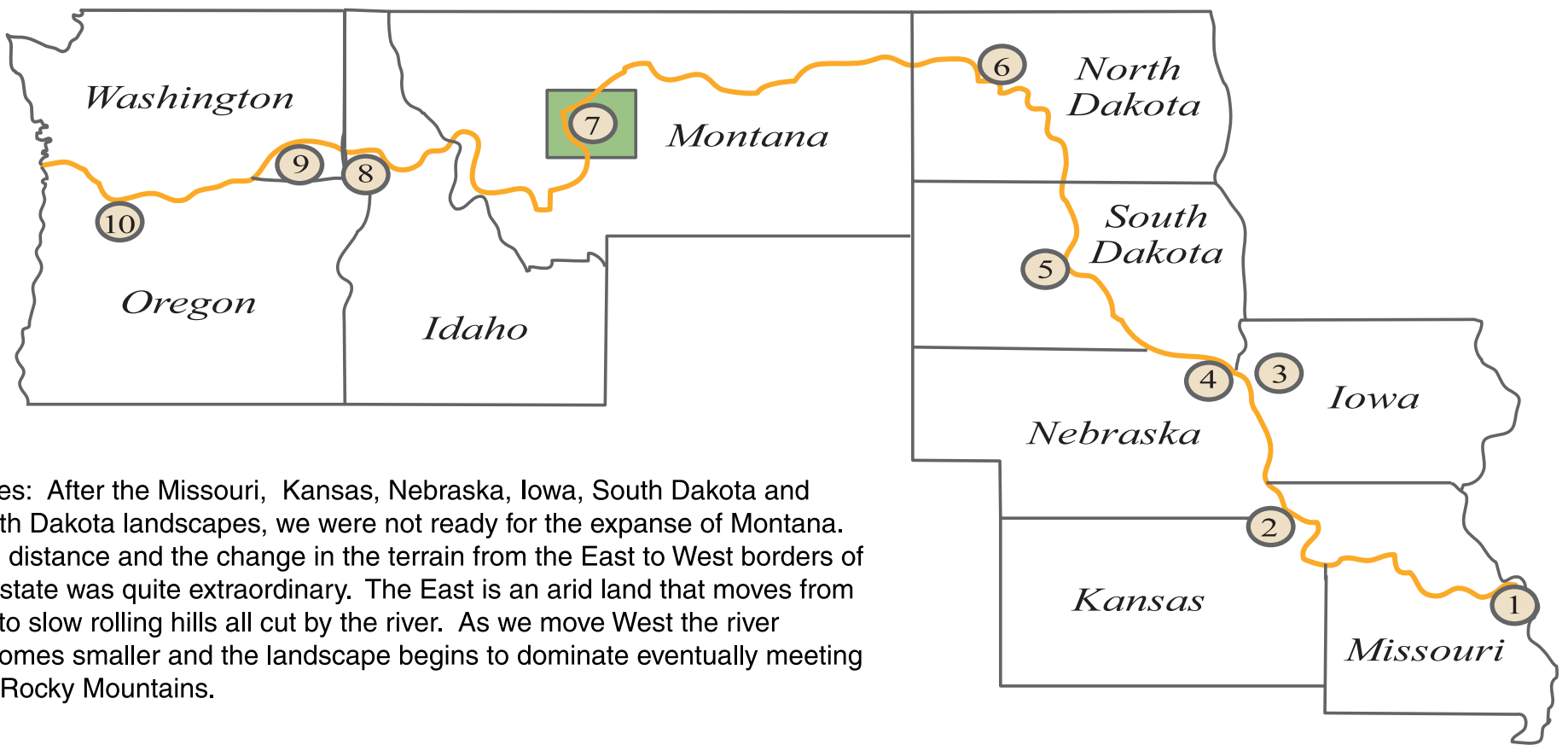
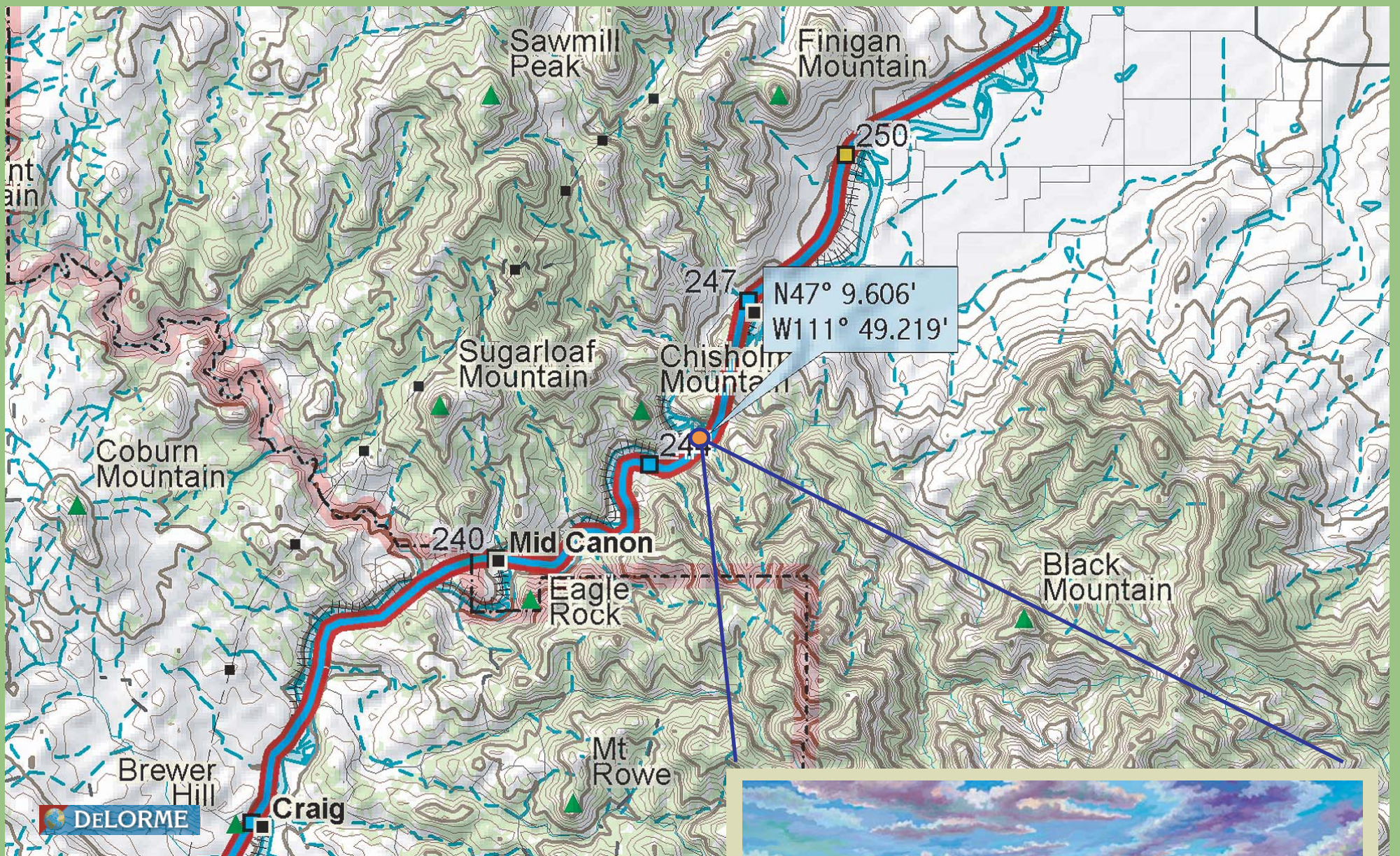


# Discover America: Montana



Notes: After the Missouri, Kansas, Nebraska, Iowa, South Dakota and North Dakota landscapes, we were not ready for the expanse of Montana. The distance and the change in the terrain from the East to West borders of the state was quite extraordinary. The East is an arid land that moves from flat to slow rolling hills all cut by the river. As we move West the river becomes smaller and the landscape begins to dominate eventually meeting the Rocky Mountains.
